



Available as an audiobook on RBDigital.


*The story of Air National Guard Major Mary Jennings Hegar and how she fought to give women serving on the front lines the credit they deserve.*

Available as an audiobook on Hoopla


*The story of the only survivor from Operation Redwing, Navy SEAL team leader Marcus Luttrell.*

Available as an E-book & audiobook on Hoopla


*The story of a group of female warriors who served alongside Special Operations soldiers in Afghanistan.*

Available as an E-book on Hoopla.







Available as an audiobook on Hoopla.


*A timely, nonstop action-adventure about the War on Terror and a family torn apart.*

Available as an E-book on Hoopla.


*Based on the true story of the French villagers in WWII who saved thousands of Jews, this novel tells how a group of young teenagers stood up for what is right.*

Available as an E-book on Hoopla.


*A fast-paced, absorbing novel about the first girl to join a prestigious military academy. A perfect blend of high-stakes suspense and romance.*





Available as an E-book on Hoopla.



Available as an E-book on Hoopla.


*This is a heartwarming story of a World War I war horse who was as brave and strong as any soldier.*

Available as an E-book on Hoopla.


*A young bear cub dreams of accompanying Papa when he leaves on a mission. Papa's backpack acknowledges the difficult and emotional process of separation during deployment.*

Available as an E-book on Hoopla


*This nonfiction picture book explores art, desperation, and one man's incredible idea for saving ships from German torpedoes in World War I.*





*Packed with exciting facts & important aspects on military animals, this title also provides historical context, compelling photos, and critical thinking activities.*




**Craig & Fred: A Marine, A Stray Dog, and How They Rescued Each Other** by Craig Grossi

*A heartwarming story of a stray dog and a U.S. Marine who met in Afghanistan and who changed each other's lives forever.*




**Immortals VS. Navy Seals**


**War Girls** by Adele Geras
